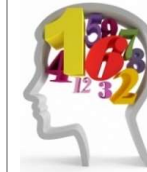
PHONICS & READING

We are developing our knowledge of our sounds, blending, word-building and sentence writing in phonics sessions.

NUMERACY & MATHS



In our number work we are working on recognising and writing numerals, counting forwards and backwards, addition and subtraction within 10 and sharing amounts out equally.

Some of our Maths learning will be done as part of our Scotland topic but we will also cover topics such as time and money which are areas you can involve your child in at home as well.
