Literacy(Reading)

During this term the class will be exploring our range of new non-fiction books.

The class will also be actively encouraged to borrow books from the class library. The children will be able to choose from a range of both fiction and non-fiction books. They will be able to take the books home and will have the opportunity to change their book on a Friday.

As part of our Listening and Talking will be looking at some examples of Scottish poetry.

Literacy(Writing)

This term we will be continuing to work on developing dictionary skills to improve spelling and vocabulary. The children have now all been given a personal dictionary to use during writing activities. These dictionaries have the common words printed in them so the children can check their spelling and record any new vocabulary they learn.

The genres we will be working on this term will be poetry and personal and imaginative writing.

Interdisciplinary Learning

Primary 3 will be focussing on The Romans as their main topic.

They will explore 'The Romans' place in history, the impact they have had on our lives and the evidence they left behind.

During our visit to the Museum the class will take part in a Gladiator workshop and have the opportunity to handle Roman artefacts.

Numeracy

We will be revising the 2, 5 and 10 times tables before introducing the 3 and 4 times tables. The children will use a range of practical tasks, games and interactive whiteboard activities to help reinforce their learning. The children will explore different strategies they can use to help them work out their answers. The link to division and fractions will also be investigated. Lots of encouragement and regular practice at home will help consolidate this work.
