<u>Literacy & Language</u>

Primary 4 have started 2016 exploring Scots language through poetry, songs and stories. In listening and talking we will be focussing on identifying key words and using these to create our own texts. In reading we are developing our skimming and scanning skills and in writing we are working on instruction writing.

Numeracy & Maths

The main numeracy topics this term will be multiplication and division. Please encourage your child to practise all known times tables as much as possible, as instant recall is very important in your child's progress in many other numeracy concepts. In Maths, we will be looking at 2D & 3D shape, along with practical skills in money.
