#### Maths

# Learning Across the Curriculum

In RME this term, Mrs Denham will be developing the children's understanding of Hinduism. Within Health and Wellbeing the children will be looking further into the rights and responsibilities of children using the United Nations Charter of Children's Rights. Within our social subjects learning, we will be discovering the history of Mary Queen of Scots - something we are already finding quite interesting!

This term we are working on understanding the difference between facts and opinions. From there we want to be able to spot these in different types of texts, as well as write our own.
