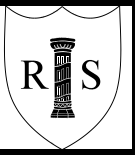

Literacy & Language

In reading I intend to introduce literature groups to P5, which gives the children more choice in what they read as well as greater independence in a reading group. Numeracy & Maths

In maths we will be finding out all the ways we can measure things using different increments, including the all-important concept of time!
