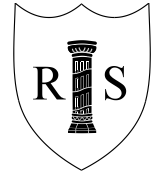

## Primary 3 Term 3 Newsletter

### Literacy

In reading this term the children will explore non-fiction texts during their class reading and homework. They will complete a range of reading skills associated with these books.

In writing we will be looking at posters, imaginative writing and recapping on reports.

We will also continue to work on our dictionary skills and introduce some editing skills.

### Numeracy and Maths

In class we will be continuing to work on strategies to help the children develop their speed and accuracy using the four number computations. They will also be introduced to fractions using a variety of strategies including pictures, number lines and practical activities. Working on their times tables at home would be of a huge benefit at this time as it links in well with multiplication and division.

In maths the children will be focusing on Measure including weight and length, Shape and Angles.

### Interdisciplinary Learning

Primary 3 will be focusing on science and social outcomes through the topic of the Rainforest. The children will explore the location, weather, and the adaption of plants and animals who survive in this unique and fascinating environment. We will also look at the impact of deforestation. As part of this topic we will be visiting Dynamic Earth to get the project off to an interesting start.

### R.M.E

This term we will be learning about some of the beliefs, traditions and practices of Hinduism.

### HWB

During Health Week the children had the opportunity to take part in a range of activities including rugby, karate, Relaxed Kids and Kic Dance.

We will also be looking at how we can look after the community, the home and school environment and how we can reduce pollution by recycling and re-using things. We will continue to practise relaxation and mindfulness as a follow-up to our Relaxed Kids sessions.

As part of P.E, the children will take part in orienteering and athletics.

### Homework

This term the children will be given a spelling activity grid from which they can choose an activity to complete each week. All the activities were covered last term so the children will have had experience of each one. They will continue to do their maths homework on the sheet.
