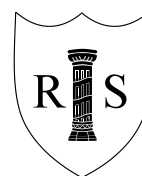

### Literacy

Within Listening & Talking this term pupils will be looking at how to present effectively to an audience. As a class they will create criteria for a successful presentation which will then be used to assess a personal talk they will give to the whole class or a small group.

During writing this term pupils will have an opportunity to write about their own personal experiences as we look at how to effectively plan, write and edit personal reflective accounts.

Pupils will be given an opportunity for greater independence a choice within reading this term as we introduce a Literacy Café and Daily 3 Reading approach.

### Maths / Numeracy

Within Maths this term we will be looking at Information Handling. Pupils will use data collected from circuit sessions in P.E. to allow them to then experiment with the creation of different data tables both written and with the use of ICT.

In Numeracy pupils will continue to consolidate and practice their times tables linking this with division and fraction work.

We will also be looking at Addition and Subtraction and exploring different methods and strategies for working out calculations mentally, with some time also spent looking at written calculation methods.

### Musical Showcase

In conjunction with Mrs Stentiford and Primary 6, Primary 4 will be taking part in a music and learning showcase.

Pupils will be showing off some of their musical talents in a short concert to parents.

Primary 4 parents will also be invited into the classroom to watch the premier of the pupils' Signalong I-Movies along with a chance to find out about some of the other learning that has been taken place.

The Musical Showcase will take place on the afternoon of Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> May, further details will be sent out in due course.

### H&WB

To link in with our Social Studies topic of Food and Farming, this term we will be looking at the relationship between food and health. In particular developing an awareness of the journeys which our food takes to get from Farm to Fork and also how we can ensure we are eating a balanced diet by looking at the Eat Well Plate.
